

"Sight Award" Lions Eye Research Application

The "Eye Research Sight Award" is a recognition award given to an individual or group who has contributed or displayed outstanding and dedicated service to his/her club and/or community with ideals of eye research in mind. The criteria may include fundraising activities that benefit MLERF, dedicated work or volunteerism on projects or activities to support the blind or sight impaired, or other overall visual related service, participation, and donations that further the goals of eye research.

A Lions Club may qualify and apply for a "Sight Award" when there has been a minimum increase of \$1,000.00 in their eye research donations from the previous year. The club must give the award. An individual cannot purchase the award. The recipient may be a Lion, LEO, community member, or group as determined by the club. Lions and Leo Clubs are limited to earning one award per year. A club may choose to present its award(s) in subsequent years.
